Club Purpose

The Be Amazing Clubs strive to actively impact the community in a positive way. Meetings should focus on community service projects, which may vary in their reach and depth. Those impacted can range from members of the same school/organization to those out in our community and beyond. Projects can range from an activity that is completed within one meeting to a project that takes many meetings to complete. Clubs are encouraged to collaborate with local businesses and organizations to complete projects.

A goal would be to progress to a point where the projects are student-driven.

Club Membership

Students should complete an application prior to joining the club.

Membership requires students to follow the Be Amazing Code of Conduct.

***The application and Code of Conduct are included.*

*** Depending on the number of advisors, it may be helpful to limit membership in your club to 20 to 25 students.*

Project Funding

In June 2017, the Be Amazing group established a 501c3 non-profit fund through the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin. The purpose of this fund is to provide monies enabling groups to complete projects that positively impact the community. If your club needs such funding, please complete the application on the Be Amazing website: www.beamazingday.com. Club advisors will be notified of approval status within 3 weeks of application.

Please be sure to document your projects through photos and videos. It would be great to include “work in progress” as well as the final results and culminating activities.

We ask that you frequently share updates with us.

Parent Communication

The membership application requests parent contact information, including email addresses. It is recommended that parents are included in communications that the club members receive from you, so they are aware of all activities and events.

You may also consider creating a Closed Group on Facebook for your individual club. This is a great way to showcase your club's progress.

Please be sure that you set this up as a closed group which requires parents to request access to the page.

Club Meetings

Some tips and ideas from advisors of the 2017-2018 clubs:

- * Kick off the first meeting by viewing the Be Amazing power point and the Theme Song video. These can be accessed under the "Clubs" tab on our Webpage.
- * Meet for ½ -1 hour sessions either every week or alternating weeks.
- * Meet during the lunch hour or after school.
- * Start each meeting with a gathering where students stand (optional) and recite the "Be Amazing" pledge (enclosed). This could be followed by a sharing session where students tell about amazing acts they have witnessed or experienced.
- * Invite parents to volunteer! They could help you manage the meeting, shop for/donate supplies, be the photographer...the opportunities are endless!!
- * Be aware of which parents have not given permission for images of their child to be shared with the media.
