



## Thank you for your interest in starting a “Be Amazing” Club!

Here are some things to know:

### Club Purpose

- The “Be Amazing” Clubs strive to actively impact the community in a positive way.
- Meetings should focus on community service projects, which may vary in their reach and depth. Those impacted can range from members of the same school/organization to those out in our community and beyond.
- Projects can range from an activity that is completed within one meeting to a project that takes many meetings to complete.
- Clubs are encouraged to collaborate with local businesses and organizations to complete projects. A goal would be to progress to a point where the projects are student-driven.

### Club Membership

- Students should complete an application prior to joining the club.
- Membership requires students to follow the Be Amazing Code of Conduct.

\*\*The application and Code of Conduct are included.

\*\* Depending on the number of advisors, it may be helpful to limit membership in your club to 20 to 25 students.

\*\*Be sure to add all student information to the club spreadsheet for each member.

### Project Funding

In June 2017, the Be Amazing group established a 501c3 non-profit fund through the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin. The purpose of this fund is to provide monies enabling groups to complete projects that positively impact the community. If your club needs such funding, please complete the application on the Be Amazing website.

### Let us know about your projects!!

Please be sure to document your projects through photos and videos. It would be great to include “work in progress” as well as the final results and culminating activities.

We ask that you share updates with us on a monthly basis (but more frequently would be great!).

You may also consider creating a Closed Group on Facebook for your individual club. This is a great way to showcase your club's progress. Please be sure that you set this up as a closed group which requires parents to request access to the page.

“Be Amazing” is a charitable organization established in May of 2017, to honor those impacted by tragedy in the Central Wisconsin area.

Through the “Be Amazing fund” (Which is a 501c3 nonprofit fund under the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin), “Be Amazing” is able to provide funding to people and groups to enable them to complete community service projects.

We have annual fund-raising events in place, such as our Annual “Be Amazing” Dine Out, to replenish the “Be Amazing fund”. Our organization also depends on outside donations to allow us to continue disbursing these funds for kindness projects.

“Be Amazing” is run by a board that has adults members from the Central Wisconsin area. These board members discuss and vote on fund requests that are submitted, as well as run the day to day operations of the organization.

Youth involvement is also a big component of our organization, and currently there are more than a dozen school-based “Be Amazing” clubs within the Central Wisconsin area school districts. Each club has its own plan for random acts of kindness and community service projects that they complete during the school year. These clubs can also apply for funding through the “Be Amazing fund” to complete projects. We are always looking for more schools to get involved and start clubs.
